Renewal Process For Uchcha Madhyamik (Higher Secondary) level

The study centres of The West Bengal Council of Rabindra Open Schooling are located mostly Govt. Schools / Govt. aided Schools / Govt. Sponsor Schools. All Study Centre under WBCROS must be renewed every year after one year of the affiliation at Uchcha Madhyamik (Higher Secondary) level.

The Renewal process through online mode of The West Bengal Council of Rabindra Open Schooling starts at the beginning of every year. One Month will be given to the Study Centre for complete the online renewal process. After completion of the online process all Study Centre's must be Submitted Printed provisional Renewal certificate along with all following relevant documents for getting Renewal Certificate as per notified date & time specified by this Council.
